A tax rate of \$0.0900 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3 from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 28, 2026 at 6:00 PM at the Center Point Independent School District Cafeteria, 200-A Avenue B, Center Point, TX.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting THE KERR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #3 at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned
